

SKI SLED^{CE}

(Part of the “SKI” range of products)

The Ski Sled has been designed for the evacuation of non-ambulant individuals in areas where space is limited, such as congested hospital wards and buildings with narrow corridors or single width fire doors.

Features & Benefits:

- The tough, slippery base enables individuals to be moved easily over virtually any interior floor surface.
- The foam pad and the internal nylon support struts give protection to the individual while being moved.
- Large foot pocket.
- 3 seatbelt style buckles (metal) and webbing straps.
- Wall mountable, wipe clean bag

Using the SKI Sled:

- In an Emergency the Ski Sled is quickly removed from its wall mountable storage bag and taken to the individual.
- The patient is then transferred on to the Ski Sled which can be performed either from a bed, floor or chair.
- Place feet within the foot pocket.
- If pillows are available place these on the chest and leg area of the individual (for comfort once strapped in).
- Secure the individual in place on the pad using the seat belt style cross straps.
- Using the end pulling handles the individual can be moved to a safe area. When going down stairs it is important to pull the individual feet first.
